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- 1) **OPTIONS:** Option to renew for an additional term.
- 2) **PROVISIONS:** In accordance with **Exhibit A, Section 3.A. Term of the Participating Addendum** of the original contract referenced above between the State of Colorado, acting by and through the **Department of Personnel and Administration, State Purchasing Office** ("State"), and the **Conserve-A-Watt Lighting, Inc.** ("Contractor"), covering the term **06/30/2011** through **02/28/2013**, the State hereby exercises its option for an additional term beginning **03/01/2013** and ending on **02/28/2014** which shall result in an increase in the amount of goods/services provided by the Contractor. Unless specified otherwise in this **Option Letter**, such performance shall be at the same rates and same terms specified in the original **Participating Addendum**, as amended.

As the **Participating Addendum** represents a State Price Agreement where unit pricing is established, the amount of the current fiscal year contract value has not changed as consideration for services/goods ordered under the original **Participating Addendum**, as amended, for the current fiscal year 2013. The original **Participating Addendum (CMS 33989)** effective 06/30/2011 was amended by **Amendment 1 (CMS 41346)** with effective date 02/28/12, and **Amendment 2 (CMS 44519)** with effective date 05/25/12.

- 3) **EFFECTIVE DATE.** The effective date of this **Option Letter** is 02/20/2013 or upon approval of the State Controller or his designee, whichever is later.
